Most of us don't need a medical checkup more than once a year, but dogs and cats are different.

Pets, on average, age up to seven times faster than humans. By age two, most have already reached adulthood. At age four, many pets are entering middle age. By age seven, pets are considered seniors, and at age ten they enter the geriatric stage of their lives.

**The bottom line!** Taking your pet to the veterinarian once a year is the same as seeing your doctor just once every seven years! You would not wait seven years to see your doctor or dentist for a checkup. Some pets are notorious for hiding signs of illness until they are almost at a crisis stage. **Wellness care is a critical part of your pet's health.**

## Your best friend can't say "ouch"!



Many times pets are sicker internally than they let us know. A routine wellness exam can identify or prevent medical conditions early before they become major problems.

Conditions such as dental disease, diabetes, arthritis, allergies and heart disease can be diagnosed early, and many cancers, especially skin cancer, can also be detected.


## Parasites

External parasites such as fleas and ticks can cause a range of problems, including skin redness, excessive scratching, anemia, allergic reactions, or contraction of diseases carried by these parasites. Mosquito bites are the cause of transmission of internal heartworm disease to both dogs and cats.

Internal parasites such as roundworms, hookworms, whipworms, tapeworms, coccidia, and giardia are commonly spread outside to unsuspecting pets. Tapeworms specifically are spread through flea infestations.

Many of these parasites are also transmissible to humans. Children are especially susceptible, as they spend a lot of time playing outdoors and have a tendency to put dirty fingers and other objects in their mouths.

We recommend a ONCE MONTHLY flea, heartworm, and intestinal parasite preventative for your pet beginning as early as 8 weeks old. Tick preventative products are also available for those pets at high

## Juvenile Wellness Plan • 1-4 years of age

Although senior pets may not have the energy of youth, they still have plenty of love and companionship to offer. Often our senior pets require proactive management of chronic disease. Our Senior Wellness Plan is specifically designed for this loving group of friends.

- **Vaccinations**

Your older pet will receive testing for the pancreas, as well as more complete liver and electrolyte values. Urinalysis detects urinary tract infection, dehydration, and evaluates kidney function more completely than bloodwork alone.

## Add Options to Your Monthly Plan

By age three, more than 80 percent of dogs and cats show signs of gum disease, which, if left untreated, can lead to serious illness and put additional demands on the heart, liver, and kidneys. In addition, cats are susceptible to retroviral infections that can cause serious disease. Add a dental cleaning and/or feline retroviral testing to your monthly plan for just a few dollars more!

### Healthy Mouth Dentistry

Designed to provide general anesthesia as well as tooth scaling and polishing, dental cleaning can help to make a healthier pet! If problems such as gum disease, cavities, or loose teeth are found during the procedure, additional costs will be incurred at the time of dentistry. You will be provided information and an estimate by the doctor over the phone if additional work is necessary.

### Feline Retroviral Testing

Feline leukemia and feline immunodeficiency virus are highly contagious diseases that severely affect a cat's ability to fight off infection. Feline leukemia sometimes leads to cancer. There is no cure for these diseases.
